Contacting School

We would like to remind all parents and carers that year group email address should only be used for queries about learning and information regarding a child which is linked to learning.

Class teachers are engaged with front-facing classroom duties and therefore emails sent to year group addresses will not necessarily be seen or acknowledged during the school day.

The year group staff will aim to respond to pressing enquiries within 48 hours and all other queries within one week.

Anything of an urgent nature - particularly if relevant for the beginning of a school day where teachers are busy preparing and may not see emails - should be sent via the school office.

Emails sent to the Inclusion team will be acknowledged with a message to confirm receipt and responded to within 7 working days.

During the course of a school day, staff, including leaders, are generally engaged with pupils and staff and therefore need to set realistic timescales in order to facilitate the needs of all members of the school community.

1 Enjoy reading this Sunday's Gospel

Jesus went back home with his disciples, and such a large crowd had gathered that they did not even have chance to eat. When Jesus' family heard what he was doing, they set out to take him away with them, convinced he was out of his mind. Some teachers of the law came down from Jerusalem and were disapproving and complaining about him. They falsely and foolishly claimed that Jesus' powers were not from God, but that he was using evil powers to heal people. Then Jesus' concerned mother and brothers arrived outside and sent in a message asking for him to come out to them. A crowd was sitting round Jesus at the time the message was passed to him, 'Your mother and brothers and sisters are outside asking for you.' Jesus replied, 'Who is my mother and who are my brothers?' And looking round at those sitting around him, he said, 'These people are also my mother and my brothers and sisters. Anyone who does the will of God is my brother or sister or mother.'
